<p>13.04</p>		<p>The Rhenish Republic, a private issue of 1923 mentioned in Mi for the separatist movement in the Rhineland during the French and Belgian occupation. All stamps are NH, all 4 fonts present: 2 on 10 Mil., 3 on 20 Mil., 3 on 30 Mil. and 2 on 50 Mil, originally a horizontal strip of 10, overprinted on sheets of Mi 314. <p>13.05</p>		<p>Sudetenland, 1938 overprinted Czech stamp for Asch Mi 4b, NH, top margin with Brunel certificate. Only 100 stamps were overprinted in black, only 10 possible with top margin. Mi evaluation € 1000.</p>	<p>\$200.00</p>

13.06		<p>1st printing of the so-called "Spitler" stamp created by stamp dealers Lawrence & Graves used from Berlin, Oklahoma on Hitler's birthday, April 20, 1943. This unique example was removed from the original postcard making a partial thin. The black dot is ink. This private issue mimicked the German Hitler birthday issue of 1940, Mi 744, but showing the girl spitting in Hitler's face. The dealers sent one 1cent Franklin postcard with the stamp attached to each town in the US named Berlin asking postmasters to mail the cards on April 20. Cards were also sent to Roosevelt and Churchill. The US Secret Service visited the dealers asking them to surrender all the stamps in their possession, the names and addresses of all involved and the printing plates. They complied but reprinted the stamps. All unused Spitler stamps and sheets of 4 are from that 2nd printing.</p>	\$30.00


